VII. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Bicentennial Report Review Response

- B. Definition of Lying
 - 1. LAW TT proposes potential changes to by-law definition of lying. His proposals attempt to exclude lies outside of University life like “social lies” – nonacademic and noninstitutional interpersonal lies, or other lies that are not related to the institution. This is meant to exclude insignificant or interpersonal lies that are entirely outside of the University or its processes, organizations, faculty, staff, or academics.
 - a) Committee members bring up examples of lies that are not necessarily related to UVA organizations or faculty/staff but should still be covered by Honor – Committee members discuss different formulations of language that would not be excluded. How much discretion is needed to adjudicate lying and excluding cases involving petty interpersonal conflicts which have no relation to the University? Most Committee members agree that we should come back with a more specific definition of social lies to redefine lying and pin down language.
