THE SUNRISE RESOLUTION
UVA Honor Committee
Sunday November 11, 2018
NOT VOTED ON BY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Honor Committee has reconsidered its imposition of a “sunset clause” on the amendments reflected in the Contributory Health Impairment Hearing Procedures (the “CHI Hearing Procedures”) and the related amendments to the Honor By-laws;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the following Resolutions adopted by the Committee on September 16, 2018; September 23, 2018; October 14, 2018; and October 21, 2018 are hereby rescinded:

'BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this amendment shall, if adopted, expire on March 3, 2019 unless the Honor Committee votes to permanently adopt the amendment on or before March 3, 2019.'

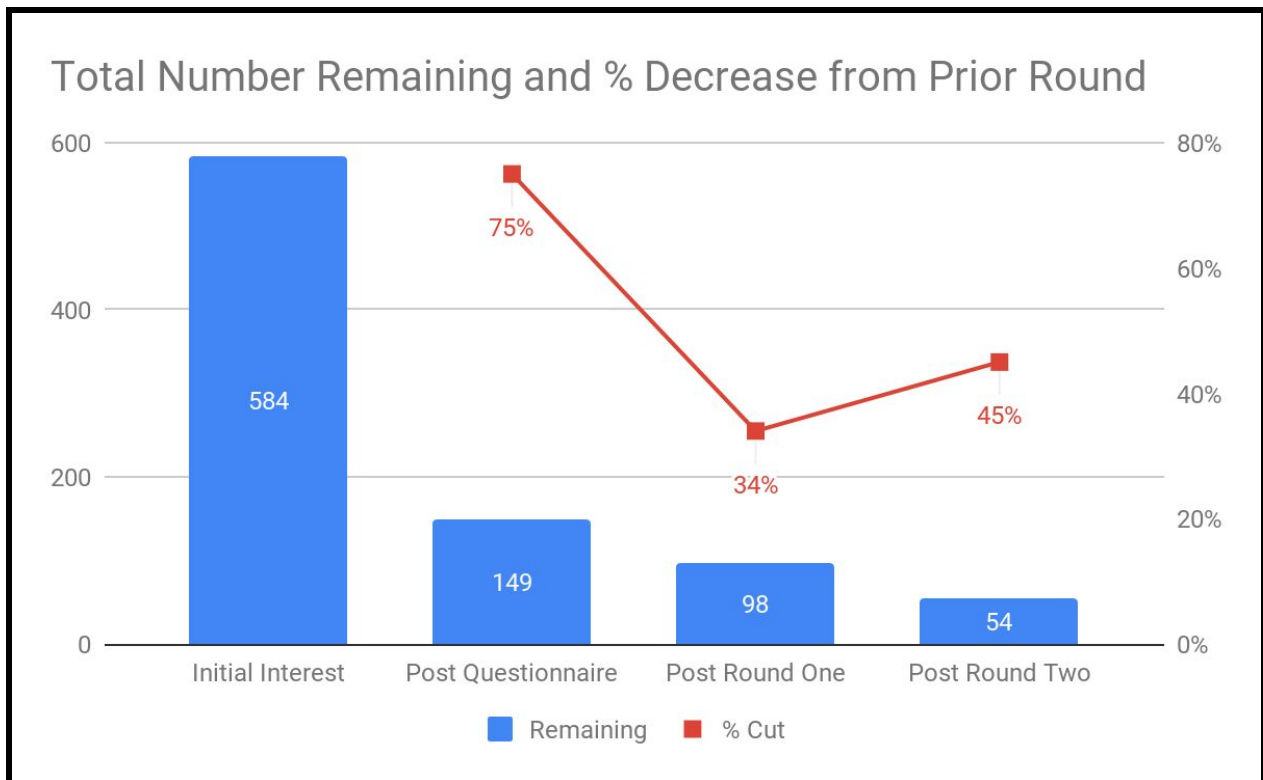
In rescinding this Resolution, the Honor Committee acknowledges that the amendments to the CHI Hearing Procedures and the related amendments to the Honor By-laws will not expire on March 3, 2019, regardless of whether the Honor Committee votes to permanently adopt such amendments. Rather, such amendments will remain in effect until the Honor Committee votes to amend or replace them.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the attached CHI Hearing Procedures and Honor By-laws, having received approval of the Office of the University Counsel, are hereby adopted and will take effect on November 12, 2018.

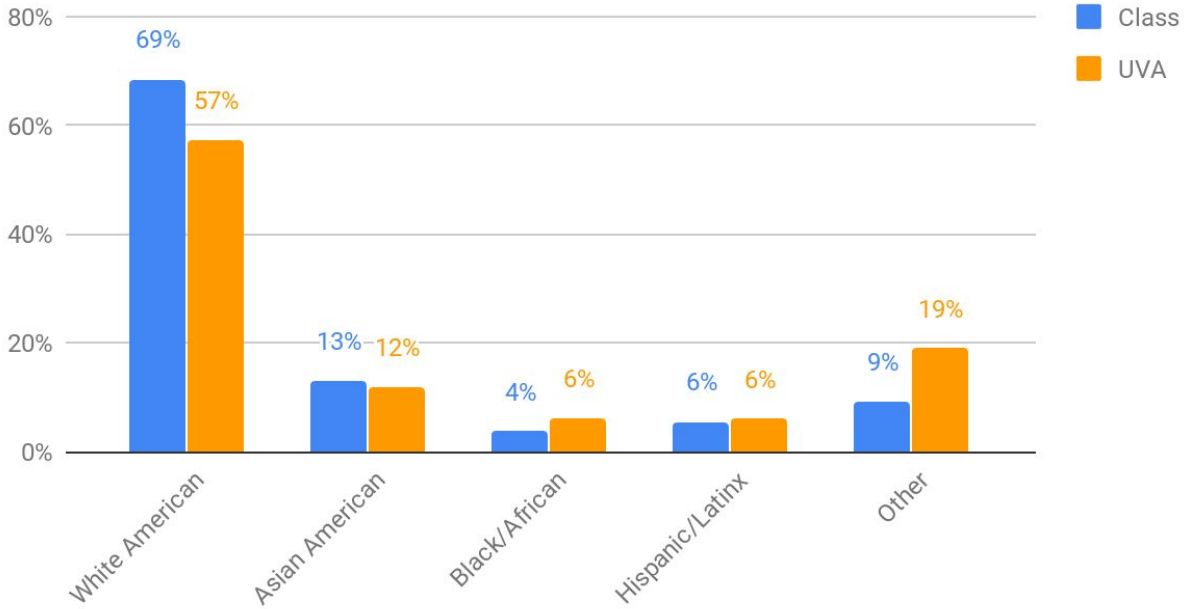

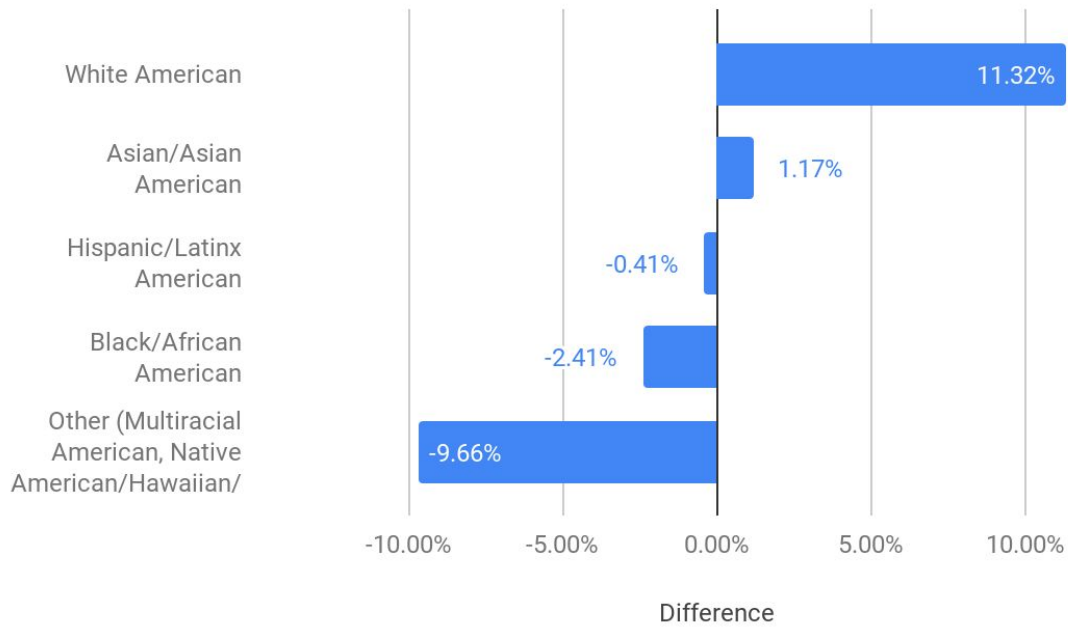

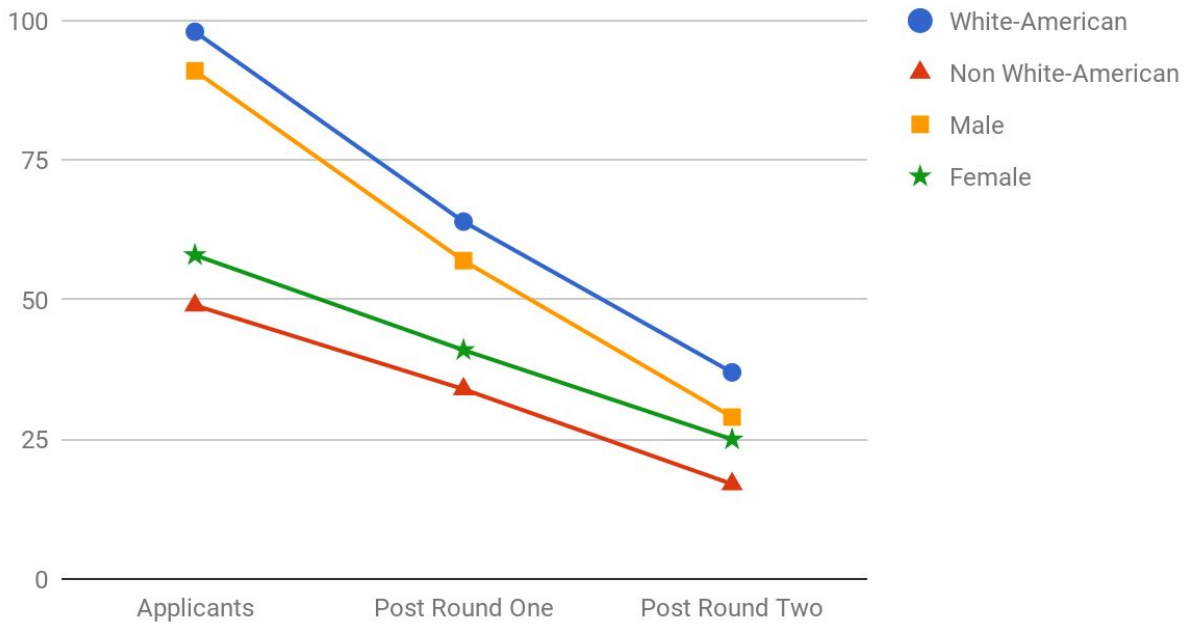
Race as a Percentage of Support Officer Class and UVA



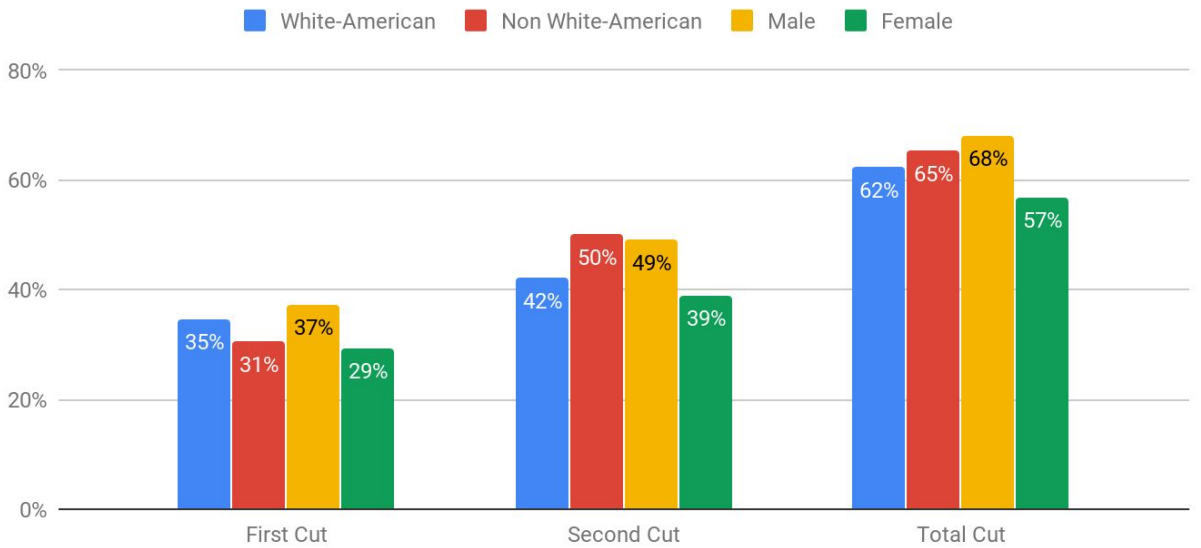
Support Officer Class Race as Percentage Difference vs UVA

Proposed Constitutional Amendment
Honor Committee: Additional Engineering Representative
NOT VOTED ON BY COMMITTEE

Article III, Section 1 of the Honor Committee Constitution currently reads:

Section 1: The Honor Committee shall consist of two elected representative members from each school of the University and three additional representative members elected from the College of Arts & Science as determined by each School's Constitution. Each member shall have one vote.

Article III, Section 1 of the Honor Committee Constitution be amended as follows:

Section 1: The Honor Committee shall consist of two elected representative members from each school of the University, one additional representative member elected from the School of Engineering and Applied Science and three additional representative members elected from the College of Arts & Science as determined by each School's Constitution. Each member shall have one vote.
